REFUND POLICY

Since programs are self-supporting and commitments need to be made to instructors and staff, the following refund policy will take effect. Please read carefully.

- If a program/activity is canceled by Branford Parks & Recreation, a full refund will be issued to the original payment. Exception no refunds on tickets, trips or pool passes.
- To avoid classes being canceled at the last minute due to insufficient enrollment and in order to accommodate waitlists, refund requests must be made no later than five(5) business days before the program begins.
- Refunds are generally not given once a program has begun, however, in the event of injury or illness, a refund request will be considered if accompanied by a doctor's note.
- Absolutely no refunds will be given for any unused portion of a program/activity.
- All refunds are subject to a \$10.00 processing fee.
- When a program/activity is run by a third party vendor, no refunds will be given 5 business days prior to the start of program/activity.
- All refunds are issued back in the original payment format, except cash.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If the Branford Public Schools are canceled or dismissed early, all recreation programs and activities will be canceled. If schools have a delayed opening, programs will continue as scheduled, except for programs starting prior to 10a. Please note: If the BOE cancels their evening activities, it will be at the discretion of our department to keep evening programs on as scheduled. CHILD & ADULT AQUATICS PROGRAMS & LEARN TO SWIM PROGRAMS

American

Red Cross We offer swim lessons through our "Learn to Swim Program" taught by American Red Cross certified staff. We believe that all participants need basic aquatic safety and swimming skills. Classes are held at the Walsh **Intermediate School**, 185 Damascus Road, Branford. (Please make sure that you park in the parking lot and not in any NO PARKING ZONES). Classes include water safety topics, basic water skills and stroke techniques. The prerequisite for each level is successful demonstration of the skills from the preceding level. If there is a wrong enrollment, every effort will be made to transfer into the appropriate level depending on space.

Parent-Infant/Toddler Swim Lessons: 6 to 24 Mont Child will be introduced to the water & encouraged to feel 6 to 24 Months comfortable through water play, songs & games. Classes are not designed to teach them to swim or to survive in the water. A parent must be in the water with their child. (Class is 20 mins long)

Parent/Preschool Aquatics: 2 & 3 years old This class is designed to familiarize the child with the water and prepare them for Preschool Aquatics levels. Parents must accompany their child in the water. (Class is 20 mins.)

Preschool Aquatics Swim Lessons: 4 & 5 years old Preschoolers will be oriented to the aquatic environment while building upon basic aquatic skills and being safe around the water. (Class is 20 mins)
