December 13, 2021

The East Shore District Health Department is working together with Branford Parks and Rec and determined your child to be a contact to someone who tested positive for Covid-19. The day of exposure was **December 11, 2021.** We want to ensure your child can safely stay at home while they may become contagious or sick.

## If your child is fully vaccinated for Covid-19,

- No need to stay home (quarantine) unless they develop symptoms.
- Have a negative rapid or PCR test 5-7 days after the last exposure. Test between 12/16/21 12/18/21. Home tests are not accepted.
- Wear a mask in all public settings for 14 days. If any symptoms develop immediately self-isolate, get tested, and contact your health care provider.

Individuals are considered fully vaccinated two weeks after their second dose in a two-dose series or two weeks after a single-dose vaccine.

## If your child is not vaccinated,

- They need to quarantine and maintain a social distance of at least 6 feet from others at all times to the best of their ability.
- They can return to regular activity on day 8 (12/19/21) if they receive a negative test 5-7 days after the last exposure (12/16/21-12/18/21). They can return to school on Monday, December 20th since day 8 falls on a Sunday. If they do not test between these dates, they need to quarantine for 10 full days and can return to school on 12/22/21.
- They do not qualify for Screen and Stay at this time.

Monitor your child for symptoms (see below) and check your child's temperature twice a day. If your child develops symptoms of COVID-19, your child should be tested.

Below is a list of symptoms your child may have:

- Fever
- Fatigue
- Congestion
- Sore throat

- Muscle or Body aches
- Cough
- Runny Nose
- Headache

- New loss of taste or smell
- Nausea/vomiting or diarrhea
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
