

### Branford Walkers June 2025 Schedule

All hikes meet at 8:45 am at the hike location, **except for the June 20<sup>th</sup> hike, which meets at the finishing point, as indicated, from where we will carpool to the start.** We start hiking at 9 am. Questions about individual hikes should be addressed to the leader. **No dogs allowed.**

June 6	<b>Supply Ponds, Branford.</b> From I 95 northbound, turn right off exit 54 to traffic light at bottom of hill. From I95 southbound, turn left off exit 54 down hill to traffic light. At light, turn left onto route 1 for 0.7 miles. Then left on Chestnut St for 0.5 miles and cross causeway to parking area. Approximate GPS: 86 Short Rocks Rd, Branford. Geoff Smith 203-488-3352
13	<b>East River Preserve, Guilford.</b> From I95, take exit 59 (Goose Lane). Go north on Goose Lane about 1.7 miles, passing Bear House Hill Road. Turn right onto Sullivan Drive and drive in to large parking area at rear. Approximate GPS: 1 Sullivan Drive, Guilford. Leo Cristofar 203-214-5824
20	<b>Branford Trail 5.</b> North Boundary: From Rte 1 at Goldsmith Rd to Northford Road. <b>Meet at Northford Rd parking area</b> , east of Brookhills Rd, or park along Brookhills Rd. Sue Frechette 860-227-6520
27	<b>Quinnipiac Linear Trail, Wallingford.</b> 4 miles, flat. <u>from the Parkway, Rte 15</u> , take exit 65, Rte 150, Yalesville ---> if coming from the south, merge to the left coming off the exit ramp, at traffic light, drive directly across Rte 150 into Quinnipiac Trail parking lot ---> if coming from the north, merge off exit ramp onto Rte 150 (Masonic Ave), go 0.2 miles, take left fork, staying on Rte 150 (now Hall Ave), go 0.1 mile, at traffic light, turn left into Quinnipiac Trail parking lot. <u>to avoid highways,</u> take 17 or 22 into center of Northford. Turn left onto Rte 22 west. Go 0.3 mile, take fork to right onto Rte 150 north. Stay on Rte 150 about 5.7 miles to the destination. ---> You will be going under I91, making a left onto Center Street, crossing Main Street, crossing Rte 5, crossing railroad tracks, and then crossing the Quinnipiac River bridge. All of this is on Rte 150. After the bridge, at the traffic light, turn right into Quinnipiac Trail parking lot. Park near the rear of the lot. Sylvia Lack 203-624-1126
