

Branford Walkers September 2026 Schedule

All Branford Trail hikes meet at 8:45 am at the starting point, where we will start hiking at 9 am. Questions about individual hikes should be addressed to the leader. No dogs allowed.

Sept 4	East Shore Park , New Haven. GPS 350 Woodward Ave, New Haven. Park in the lot where the old hockey rink is located. We'll walk around the park to Fort Hale Park, where we climb a steep hill to see the New Haven harbor, then continue the walk along the Pardee seawall trail. We'll return to our cars via Townsend Avenue and some side streets. A Morris Cove community group has fixed up the old hockey rink. Vinnie believes this new rink will be for roller bladers. 11	Lake Hammonasset , Killingworth. From traffic circle at Rt 80 and Rt 79, go east for 1.5 miles. The entrance to Lake Hammonasset is 0.25 miles past the Killingworth town line, on the left. From the east, the entrance is 1.25 miles past Chatfield Hollow State Park, on the right. For GPS, use 551 Rte 80, Killingworth, CT. There is a gate at the entrance which may be locked if you get there early. Sue Frechette 860-227-6520
18	Fenwick , Old Saybrook. 4.5 flat miles. Meet Old Saybrook Memorial Park, 150 College St. I95 north, take exit 67. Bear right onto Rte 154 toward Old Saybrook for 0.7mile. At traffic light go left to stay on Rte 154 (Main Street). Go straight for 2.1 miles and left into parking lot. Sylvia Lack 203-624-1126
25	Nut Plains Woods , Guilford. GPS: 60 Cindy Lane. From Rt 95 take exit 59, follow Goose Lane north until road becomes Nut Plain Rd. Pass cemetery and Nut Plain field and dog park. Turn right onto White Birch Rd. Then right onto Cindy Lane. From Rt 80, go south on Rt 77 (Durham Rd) for 2.7 miles, turn left on Stepstone Hill Rd, right onto Nut Plain Rd to White Burch Rd to Cindy Lane. Deborah Hoyt 603-867-1047
