Mission:

The mission of the Branford School Readiness Council is to provide a system of support for all young children to enhance their school readiness and improve their developmental and educational outcomes. The Council's emphasis is to bring together parents, schools, and community organizations to collaborate on issues related to early child care and education.

What is School Readiness?

School readiness and high-quality preschool programs provide the necessary building blocks for children to be successful in kindergarten. According to the National Institute for Early Education Research, children who attend high-quality preschool programs enter kindergarten with better pre-reading skills, richer vocabularies, and stronger basic math skills. Preschool programs also foster important executive function skills by teaching children how to socialize, take turns, contribute to a group, sit, listen, and share the teacher's attention.

School Readiness in Branford

School readiness is a state-funded initiative administered by the CT Office of Early Childhood that gives income-eligible families the opportunity to access high-quality preschool programs. Currently, Branford has two School Readiness Programs: The Branford FRC at Indian Neck School and Branford Early Learning Center. Both programs are Accredited by NAEYC (National Association of Education of Young Children). Full-day, full-year school readiness slots are available to Branford children ages 3 to 4 years old who meet income eligibility guidelines.

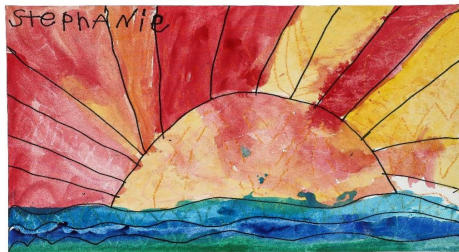
